Exclusive 'Only-On-Carnival' Tour Options In Select Caribbean Ports

For those who want to create unforgettable vacation memories in their own tropical paradise, Carnival now offers exclusive tours that not only include amenities like access to luxurious private villas but also unique enrichment activities that allow guests to fully immerse themselves in local culture and cuisine. The new tours include:

- La Casa en la Playa (Cozumel) Recently named Carnival's "Tour of the Year," this five-hour-long tour offers an exclusive luxury experience limited to 30 participants with access to a beach house with five-star service for the day, complete with a personal chef and wait staff. Participants can also learn how to cook authentic Mexican cuisine, make refreshing Margaritas and mojitos, or simply relax on a white-sand beach while enjoying pampering and attentive service.
- Eat, Drink & Dance (Ocho Rios) This tour is definitely on "island time," designed to please guests' palates and awaken their senses through Jamaica's unique food, music and culture. - Family Treasure Hunt with Lunch at Blue Lagoon (Nassau) Families are sure to have a blast during this fun-filled adventure where participants must discover hidden treasures, collect clues and answer trivia questions on their journey to win the Pirate's Bounty!
