(November 9, 2016) — The steel cutting ceremony of the bow section of the fourth Royal Class ship for [Princess Cruises](#) was held Nov. 3 at Fincantieri shipyard in Castellammare di Stabia, Italy. This new build design follows sister ships [Royal](#), [Regal](#), and [Majestic](#) Princess, and is scheduled for delivery in 2019.
