 rock faces, crevassed rivers of ice, and the highest peaks of <u>Denali National Park</u>. Afterwards, enjoy

 of the Park.
- Join a Denali guide and tour the unfenced wilderness of Denali National Park, with six-million acres alive with grizzly and black bears, wolves, moose, caribou, Dall's sheep and 169 bird species. Enjoy views of rolling hills, alpine tundra, broad valleys, wild rivers, and the looming, snowy magnificence of Denali Mountain at 20,310 feet, the tallest peak in North America.
- Settle into a comfortable domed observation car for a scenic railway journey south from Denali National Park to Anchorage, taking in majestic views along the way. Upon arrival, enjoy a celebratory dinner at Crow's Nest Restaurant offering 360-degree views of the snowcapped Chugach Range.
